Brixton Town Centre works

Major works will begin in Brixton Town Centre in May 2009 as part of the final phase of the 'Improving Brixton Town Centre' project. The project will last for around eighteen months, and will create intermittent delays on Brixton Road.

From early May, and for a duration of approximately four weeks, utilities works will take place at the junction of Brixton Lane and Coldharbour Lane meaning that:

- Traffic on Brixton Road at the junction with Coldharbour Lane will be reduced to one lane south bound into Effra Road
- There will be no entrance to Coldharbour Lane from Acre Lane, Brixton Hill and Brixton Road
- Traffic will be advised to seek alternative routes

Further disruptions to traffic flow will be reported in the 'next steps' section of tfl.gov.uk/brixtonsquare and will be reported on Traffic Radio (www.trafficradio.org.uk)
