



**Olympic Torch Route
Sunday 6 April**

The procession for the Olympic Torch through London will take place on Sunday 6 April. This will be dealt with as a Police 'bubble' with motorcyclists escorting the Torch. There will be traffic holds of approximately 15 minutes but no road closures as such. However, the Police will need to react to events of the day such as demonstrations and these may require the temporary closure of roads surrounding the incident.

The intended route is as follows:

- 10.30 Wembley Arena Square
- 11.00 Ladbroke Grove
- 11.30 Notting Hill Gate
- 12.00 Oxford Street
- 12.45 China Town
- 13.00 Trafalgar Square, down Whitehall around Big Ben pausing at Downing Street, crossing Westminster Bridge then along Embankment to Waterloo Bridge
- 13.30 Southbank Centre, Royal Festival Hall
- 14.45 St Paul's Cathedral
- 15.45 Whitechapel Road
- 16.45 Stratford
- 17.00 Canary Wharf
- 18.00 North Greenwich
