

How much does it cost?

The Congestion Charge is £8 a day payable by midnight on the day of travel. Please note that payment can **only** be made by text on the day of travel.

Residents registered for the residents' 90% discount can pay £4 for five consecutive charging days by sending a text on the first day of travel before midnight.

Text messages are charged at your service provider's standard rate. Transport for London does not add any additional charges.

Paying the Congestion Charge by text message

- a** Text the **last four digits** of your credit or debit card number to **81099**
- b** Your payment confirmation text message should arrive within 30 minutes
- c** Make a note of the payment receipt number
- d** Always read the reply text message. If there has been a problem, it will tell you what to do

Pay next day

Pay by midnight the day **after** you travel and you pay £10. This is **only** payable by **phone** on **0845 900 1234** or **online** at **cclondon.com** There is no residents' discount for pay next day.

Paying for any other vehicle

Text the **last four digits** of your card number followed by a space, followed by the vehicle registration number in full, to **81099**.

One way to ensure you always pay on time is to set a daily alert on your mobile phone.

The Congestion Charge operates Monday to Friday. The hours of operation are **7.00am – 6.00pm**. Weekends and public holidays are free.
